- Connecting strategy progress to health and system outcomes
- Providing guidance on the design and implementation of specific strategic initiatives
- Proposing revisions to the overall strategy to meet changing patient and health system needs
- Fostering collaboration with other relevant initiatives, programs and/or organizations
- Identifying where additional, essential committee representation is required

QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience within the medical imaging domain as a medical imaging provider or medical imaging consumer, including but not limited to individuals from health administration, surgery, cardiology, oncology and primary care, as well as individuals involved in research employing medical imaging and individuals with experience working in Independent Health Facilities
